

The Town Board of the Town of Dansville, Steuben County, met on May 14, 2015, at 7:00 PM, for the regular monthly meeting.

From the public no one.

The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag was observed.

Dog Control Officer Lackey advised that cars aren't an issue at this time but dogs are crazy. He has had many complaints from the same area between neighbors. There was a dog bite incident on Sandy Hill which is in the Health Department hands. The dog is licensed and Rabies up to date. Councilman Hartwell made motion to accept the report, Councilman Jackson seconded the motion. Roll call all ayes motion carried.

Highway Superintendent Acomb advised that Soil and Water was up and looked at Kurtz Hollow. The Big Pipe is on order and should be here in 2 to 3 weeks. It is 128"X 83" and 10" gauge. The cost is \$14,807.06.

The truck we had for sale did not bring what we wanted for it. The Town of Burns will buy it for \$75,000. Attorney Vogel read over the contract from the auction place and advised that there was nothing in it preventing us from selling to The Town of Burns and rejecting the bid of \$65,800 from the Town that bid. Councilman Mahany made motion to reject the bid of \$65,800.

Councilman Jackson seconded the motion. Roll call all ayes motion carried. Councilman Mahany made motion to accept the bid of \$75,000 from the Town of Burns for the truck. Councilman Hartwell seconded the motion. Roll call all ayes. Motion carried.

The crew has been doing ditches and working in the gravel pit. They can't start grading until the Salt brine trailer comes back from Carpenters.

The 248 agreement for CHIPS money was signed. We will receive \$170,243.59 plus an extra \$ 24,686.73 that the Govenenor released for extreme winter recovery funds.

Councilman Jackson made motion to accept the report. Councilman Stauring seconded the motion. Roll call all ayes. Motion Carried.

The Supervisor's report was looked at. Councilman Stauring made motion to accept the report. Councilman Hartwell seconded the motion. Roll call All Ayes, Motion carried.

The CEO report was read, there were no questions. Councilman Hartwell made motion to accept the report. Councilman Jackson seconded the motion. Roll calls all ayes. Motion carried.

Nancy advised the board that there is an ongoing problem with residents thinking the dumpster is for their personal use. It was decided that Ray will get signs stating that there are surveillance camera on them. Ray also advised that there was a problem with the new kids across the street and he went and talked to the father.

We also still have not received payment for the damage to the carpet Councilman Mahany made motion that payment be held for the work done until the settlement is finalized. Councilman Jackson seconded the motion. Roll call all ayes. Motion carried. After discussion concerning the damaged carpet, it was agreed that the carpet should be replaced with ceramic tile instead of carpet. All agreed. An ad will go in the paper for bids.

Bids were looked at to replace the existing chemical water conditioner. Councilman Mahany made motion to go with Joel Vanderwerken. Councilman Jackson seconded the motion. Roll call all ayes. Motion carried.

The Board audited General Fund Abstract #5 95-125) for \$15,849.87, Highway Fund Abstract #5(61-74) \$ 55,115.59and T/A abstract # 5(18-19) for a total of \$130.09.

There being no further business before the board at this time Councilman Mahany made motion to adjourn, Councilman Stauring seconded it roll call all ayes motion carried Meeting adjourned at 7:57 PM.
