The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag was observed.

Public: Sheriff Cole made a presentation concerning Narcotics in Steuben County. He would like support from the area schools in the Drive against Drugs program that their department is working on. The board advised Sheriff Cole that a letter would be written in favor of his support to Arkport Central and Wayland/Cohocton Schools.

Dog Control Officer Lackey stated that cars aren't a problem this month. He has a couple dog complaints that are getting resolved. The annual night quarantine law that NYS has will be in the papers soon and will help resolve some problems. Councilman Rauber made motion to accept the report. Councilman Mahany seconded the motion. Roll call all ayes motion carried

Highway Superintendent Acomb advised the board that the repair bill for the Niche bill was only \$2150 and not the \$6000 that was expected and the truck is back. Shared services Loader has been delivered. Our excavator is here but there are some problems with it. It needs to go back to Binghamton to have the problems resolved. The crew did use it on McCurdy Road doing sluices with it. The 2005 truck we bought from Hornellsville last year had the Turbo go on it. It is in the repair shop getting fixed. The radiator went in the tractor so the guys are working on that. The possible delivery of the pipe ordered to finish Kurtz Hollow will be October 1. The other shared Service Towns are going to help put the pipe together and install it. Motion to accept the report was made by Councilman Hartwell. Councilman Mahany seconded the motion. Roll call all ayes motion carried.

Attorney Vogel suggested that we contact Tom Baldwin for recommendations as to how to answer comment to the audit report. Nancy will contact him.

The Supervisor's report was looked at. Councilman Jackson made motion to accept the report. Councilman Rauber seconded the motion. Roll call All Ayes, Motion carried.

The CEO report was looked at. Councilman Jackson made motion to accept the report. Councilman Hartwell seconded the motion. Roll call all ayes. Motion carried.

Nancy advised the board that she needed to adjust the working hours for Retirement reporting which was set in the May Meeting by RESOLUTION 2014-23. The hours should be Highway Superintendent , Assessor 8 hours and dog control 16 hour for standard work day. The court clerk should be 8 hours
